



## Family Facts



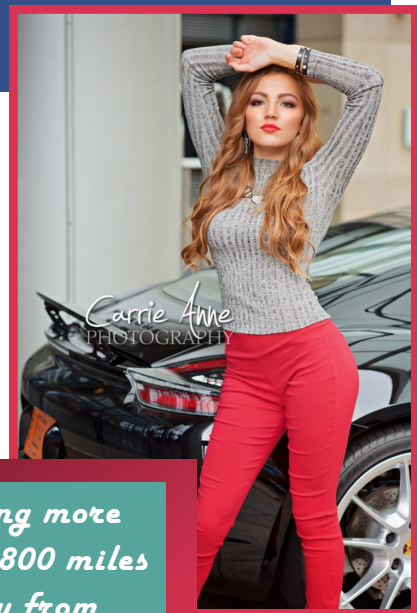

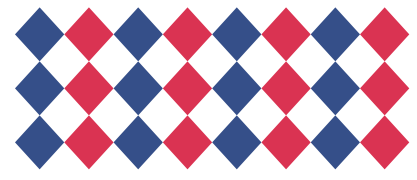
